The Canadian Golf Superintendents Association (CGSA) Scholars Fund supports "CGSA member" students attending educational programs as a means of enhancing their knowledge and skills for the turfgrass profession. The Scholars Fund provides support to CGSA Student members pursuing their educational endeavours. This financial assistance is meant to assist members in becoming better qualified for their current employment or other opportunities within the turfgrass profession.

A total of \$3,000 scholarship funds were given out by the CGSA in 2021...

Starting in 2022 The CGSA Board of Directors approved covering the membership dues for all Student members that meet the criteria. For more information please click here!

This assistance is available to all CGSA student members who are currently enrolled in <u>at least the second year</u> of a recognized turfgrass program of two (2) years duration (or longer). One year mechanic course students are also eligible.

The program is administered by the CGSA Board of Directors.

APPLICATION PREREQUISITES

APPLICANT MUST:

- 1. Be a **member** in good standing of the Canadian Golf Superintendents Association.
- 2. Be a Canadian Resident.
- 3. Have a minimum of **one season** as an **employee** on a Golf Course.
- 4. Be <u>presently enrolled</u> in at least the <u>second year</u> at a turfgrass institution in a program of <u>two (2) years</u> duration or longer or in a <u>one year</u> or longer golf course technician (mechanic) program.
- 5. Have the attached "reports" completed by:
 - The golf course superintendent at the applicant's place of employment

and

A current instructor at the educational institution.

These two (2) "reports" are to be completed and returned to the student, and included with a completed application" by the **Deadline Date:**November 30, 2022
